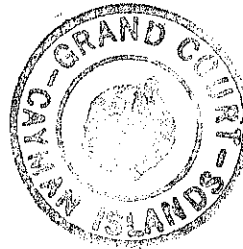

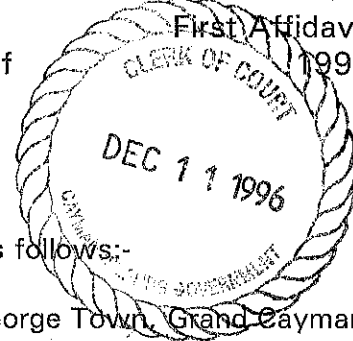

That on the 18th day of December 1995 the Director of Labour, Mr Dale Banks, awarded me the sum of C.1\$ 4,050.00 to be paid by the Defendant following a labour hearing held on 19th September 1995 and 5th December 1995 respectively. 3. That on the 10th day of September 1996, The Labour Law Appeal Tribunal dismissed the appeal of the Defendant from the said decision of the Direction of Labour and confirmed the said decision of the Director of Labour.
4. That on the 29th day of October 1996, my Attorneys received an Originating Notice of Motion dated 30th September 1996, appealing the said decision of the Labour Law Appeal Tribunal.

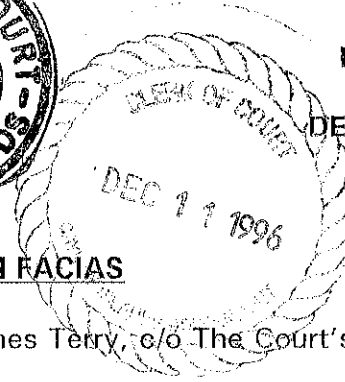
