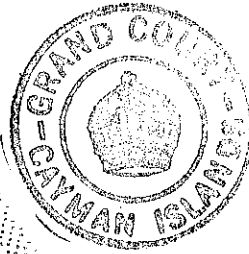

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

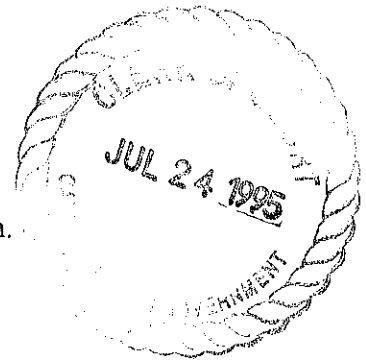

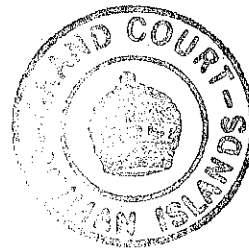

**INDORSEMENT**



1. The plaintiff is the owner of Stanwyck Plaza in George Town.
2. The defendant operates a business in the plaintiff's plaza.
3. On the 1st day of December, 1994 the defendants entered into an agreement with the plaintiff to rent No. 3 shop in Stanwyck Plaza at a monthly rent of \$850.00 payable in advance on the 1st day of each month.
4. The defendants failed to pay the rent from the 1st April, to 1st July, 1994. As a result of several demands, the first defendant, on the 15th day of July, 1994 gave the plaintiff a \$400.00 in cash and a cheque for \$3,000.00 which when presented to the bank, was returned for lack of funds. The plaintiff returned the cheque to the first defendant and demanded cash but the defendants have failed to pay

**WHEREFORE THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:**



1. The rent due = \$3,000.00
2. An order that the defendants vacate the premises by the 31st July
2. Interest at the rate of 8 3/8% per annum from the date of judgement until payment
4. Costs to be taxed.

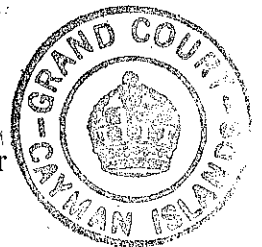
