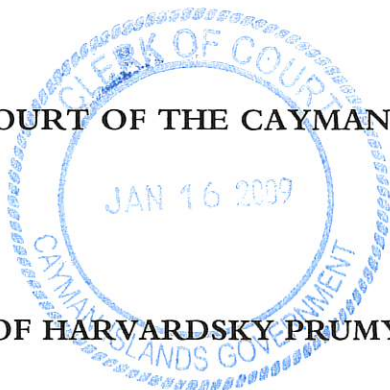

ORIGINATING SUMMONS




LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman at _____ on _____ 2009 upon an application by the Applicant, as Liquidator of Harvardsky Prumyslovy Holding A.S. (In Liquidation), for Orders that:

1. The Applicant, in his capacity as Liquidator of Harvardsky Prumyslovy Holding A.S. (In Liquidation) (the "Company"), be recognised as a foreign representative having the right to act in the Cayman Islands on behalf of or in the name of the Company.
2. The Applicant shall be entitled to inspect and obtain copies of documents from parties in the Cayman Islands that pertain to the business and affairs of the Company.
3. Without limiting the generality of Order 2, the Applicant shall be entitled to inspect and obtain copies of the following documents:
 - a. Legal files pertaining to the Company and HPH Cayman Ltd;
 - b. The books and records of HPH Cayman Ltd;

- c. Banking records for HPH Cayman Ltd; and
 - d. Audit and accounting files for HPH Cayman Ltd.
4. The Applicant shall be entitled to issue written interrogatories to any person whom the Applicant considers is in possession of information or documents pertaining to the business and affairs of the Company, including but not limited to, the trusts purported to have been created for the benefit of the Company's investors by HPH Cayman Ltd.
5. The recipient of interrogatories issued by the Applicant pursuant to Order 4 shall:
 - a. Provide all requested documents to the Applicant within 14 days of the Applicant's request;
 - b. Provide sworn written answers to the Applicant's interrogatories within 21 days of the Applicant's request; and
 - c. Have liberty to apply on 7 days notice to the Applicant.
6. Such further or other order as the Court thinks fit.
