ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 6th day of February 2009, at 9.30am on the hearing of an urgent application (as endorsed by Mr. Justice Henderson) by the Applicants seeking the following relief:

- (1) the applicant, Leandro Romero, being the Brother of the Patient, Carol Romero currently in a coma receiving medical treatment for, *inter alia*, a severe head trauma sustained when a motor vehicle collided into her on 21st January 2009, be appointed Guardian *ad Litem* of the patient for the purpose of commencing a tort action on her behalf arising from the said accident.
- (2) That the following powers be conferred upon the Guardian and Receiver:
 - a. To instruct Attorneys at Law to pursue an action for damages against the driver of the vehicle that collided into the Patient and for any other purposes ancillary thereto;


- b. To make an application for legal aid, if appropriate, on behalf of the Patient;
- c. With leave of the Court, to make payments to the said attorneys on account of legal services rendered and expenses incurred; and
- d. That the applicant shall keep proper accounts of his administration and management of the property of the Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file at Court copies of such accounts.

(3) That the costs of this application and the costs of the Guardian and Receiver incidental to and consequential upon the Order shall be paid from the estate and property of the Patient.

(4) Liberty to apply.
