

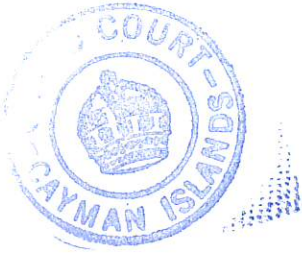

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

1. **THAT** the Plaintiff be appointed as temporary/interim Guardian of the minor child **Pressly Pak Kar Kit** (the "Child") pursuant to s.7(1) of the *Guardianship and Custody of Children's Law* (as Revised);
2. **THAT** the Plaintiff be granted temporary/interim custody of the minor child;
3. **THAT** the Plaintiff and the 1st and 2nd Defendants are work together with a view to facilitating the relocation of the minor child from Malaysia to the Cayman Islands immediately;

4. **THAT** the 1ST and 2nd Defendants be hereby granted temporary/interim day to day care and control of the minor Child with the Plaintiff to have defined access to the said child the exact terms of which access are to be agreed on between the parties;
5. **THAT** there be liberty to apply; and
6. **THAT** there be no order as to costs.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE

OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.


