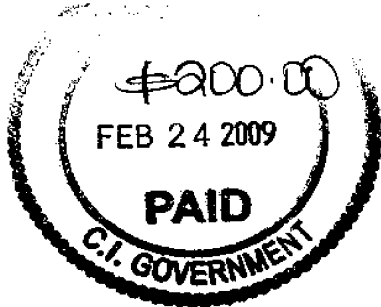

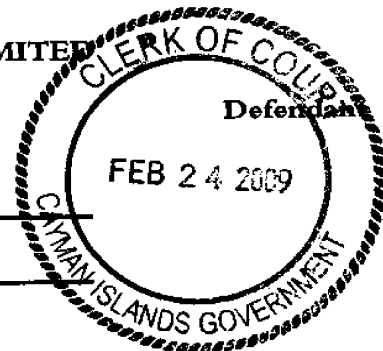

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 23 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the

THE PLAINTIFF'S CLAIM IS FOR:

1. An order that Fenris procure, authorise or otherwise cause:
 - (i) the redemption proceeds relating to the 10,537.27 shares held in the name of Fenris in Ennismore Vigeland Fund ("EVF") to be transferred directly to the Plaintiff;
 - (ii) all distributions made or to be made from the liquidation of EVF in respect of the 3,512.42 shares held in Fenris' name to be paid directly to the Plaintiff; and
 - (iii) the 7,828.22 shares in Ennismore European Smaller Companies Hedge Fund held in the name of Fenris to be transferred directly to the Plaintiff.
2. Alternatively, damages for breach of an agreement between the Plaintiff and Defendant dated 24 June 2006 ("the Clawback Agreement") supplemented by a further agreement in or around December 2006 ("the Supplemental Agreement").
4. Interest for such period and at such rate as the Court shall think just, on any amount found due.
5. Costs.
