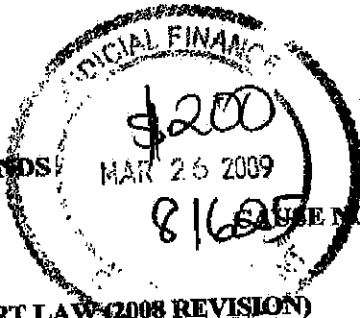


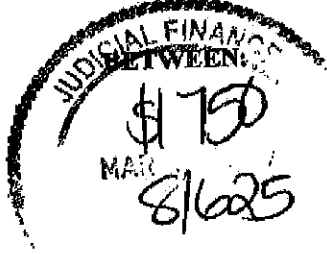

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED, attend before a Judge of the Grand Court in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on 19th day the day of May 2009, at 9:30 o'clock, on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following relief:

1. An order pursuant to Order 80/30 and 80/21 of the Grand Court Rules 1995, dispensing with service of the Originating Summons herein upon, the said Jacobus Gijsbert Hollander and permitting this Originating Summons to proceed on an *ex parte* basis;
2. An determination or declaration for the purposes of s.14 of the Grand Court Law and s.13(b) of the Mental Health Law that the Respondent, Jacobus Gijsbert Hollander, of The Pines Retirement Home, George Town, Grand Cayman, is a person incapable of managing his own affairs and of unsound mind by reason of advanced and progressive Parkinson's dementia, or other progressive mental deterioration;
3. An order pursuant to Order 80/28 of the Grand Court Rules, s.14 of the Grand Court Law and s.13 of the Mental Health Law, appointing him guardian of the person of his father, Jacobus Gijsbert Hollander, of The Pines Retirement Home, George Town, Grand Cayman, by reason of his mental incompetency as aforesaid, with all power and authority for administering his personal affairs, property and estate as more particularly set out at s.14(a) of the Mental Health Law .
4. Such further and other relief as to this Honourable Court may seem just.

THE GROUNDS for this Originating Summons include the grounds set out in the Affidavit of Steven Reginald Hollander sworn 25 March 2009 filed and the medical reports exhibited to that affidavit.
